The Hamilton Island Golf Club has some of the most spectacular views of any golf course in the world. Designed by five time British Open winner Peter Thomson, the par 71 Hamilton Island Golf Club on neighbouring Dent Island measures 6,120 metres. The only 18-hole golf course on its own island in Australia, the championship course has been designed to challenge all levels of golf enthusiasts, from novice to professional golfers.
